**NHPTV** places special emphasis on non-fiction content related to New Hampshire, Northern New England and the Boston area including:

- Programs that celebrate New Hampshire and New England's unique history and culture
- Programs about quality of life
- Programs that educate, entertain and enrich

**NHPTV** operates in a limited resource environment and seeks to engage with producers on a no-cost or limited-cost basis.

Currently **NHPTV IS ONLY ACCEPTING FINISHED PROJECTS FOR BROADCAST.**

NHPTV occasionally serves as the presenting station for national distribution. NHPTV less frequently engages in co-productions. In both instances, NHPTV will seek cost recovery on all fees incurred in the distribution and production process.
