"For score and seven years ago..." begins what may be one of the toughest challenges faced by the boys who attend the Greenwood School in the small town of Putney, Vermont.

Boys who face a range of complex learning differences attend the school. Every year, the 50 students ages 11-17 are issued this challenge: memorize and recite one of the greatest speeches in American history, the Gettysburg Address.

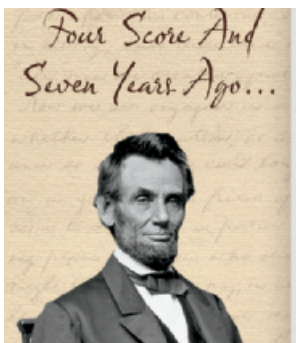


Over several months, the boys at the Greenwood School will struggle to navigate the speech and master the language that has inspired and captivated Americans for generations.

Ken Burns, whose home in Walpole is near the Greenwood School, follows the struggles and triumphs of the boys who take up the tradition of reciting the speech and who embody the spirit of freedom and integrity imbued in Lincoln's famous *Address*.

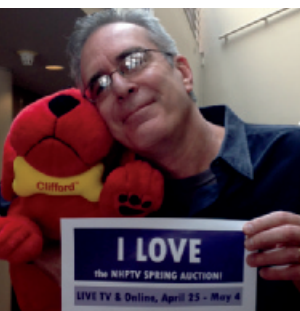

studio, prepping items, and so much more!

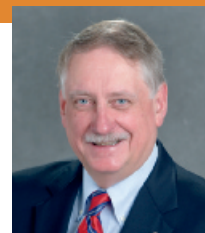
Excitement for the Auction has been ramping up for weeks. Have you seen our Auction "selfies"? Donors, bidders and volunteers have taken photos (like our favorite

points as well as point penalties for wrong answers, the school with the best teamwork is destined to win.

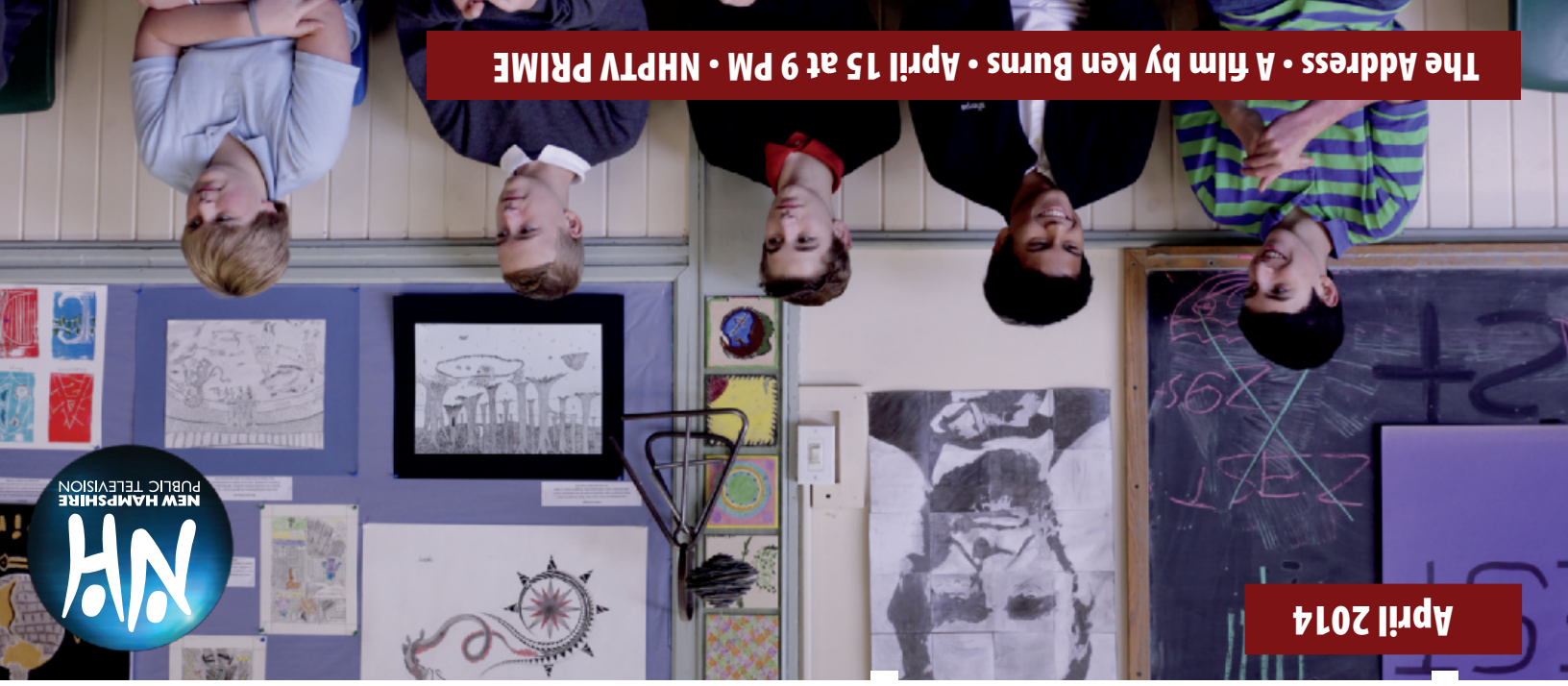
