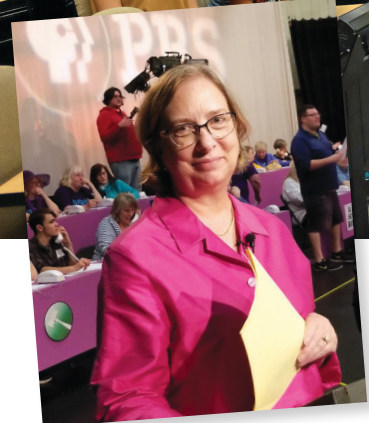

When Dr. Kristen Nevious arrived at Franklin Pierce University, she was drawn to the beautiful

hills of the Monadnock region and to the mission of the Marlin Fitzwater Center — to educate leaders of conscience in public communication.

But it’s more than wonderful cooking shows that connects her with New Hampshire PBS. “Its programs are for everyone. I remember my father-in-law watching in the nursing home. And I’ll never forget the time my toddler son first saw Big Bird at a Sesame Street LIVE event. He was always quiet, but he came alive with joy and wonder at that event. His first words were a complete sentence. When I put him in his yellow sleeper and joked that he looked like Big Bird, he said, ‘I’m not Big Bird!’

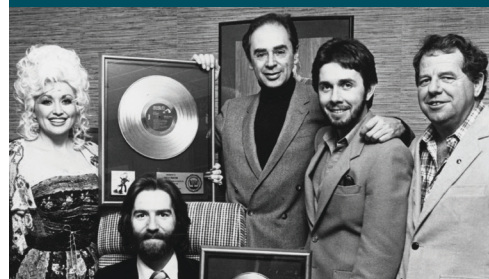
